**CLOTHING LIST**

- When choosing the clothing, think in terms of layers. Several garments that can be worn, one on top of the other, are warmer than one bulky item. In wet or snowy conditions, wool or fleece are warmer than cotton.
- Mark all clothes/equipment, especially water bottles and cameras, with your child's name.
- **Two pieces of luggage only:**
  - 1) Sleeping bag/bedroll wrapped in sturdy plastic bag, marked indelibly with name and school
  - 2) Suitcase or duffel bag with luggage tag with name and school
- Please dress in long pants, walking shoes (or snow boots), and carry a jacket on the bus trip the first day.
